**CBA Interim Head Knock Policy**

The CBA Board has instigated the following Interim Head Knock Policy, effective from the weekend of 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2018.

1. Any incident involving a knock to the head must be reported to the Floor Controller
2. The Floor Controller (or a suitably qualified medical specialist ie Doctor, Physio etc) will administer the ACC SportSmart Concussion Protocol
3. If one or more of the visible signs, symptoms, or errors in memory of the protocol are present, then the player must be removed from the game and referred to a medical doctor for assessment.
4. The Player is unable to play until they have been cleared by a doctor.

This Policy is to be adhered to in all CBA administered competitions, and will be reviewed at the conclusion of the 2018 season.
