15 Rounds – Triple Round Robin
Hoben Trophy will be awarded to the #1 placed team on the ladder after the regular season ends (15 rounds)
SF - 1 vs 4; 2 vs 3
F - Both SF winners

<b>Miles Toyota Women's Premier League (Six Teams, 18 rounds)</b>
10 Rounds – Double Round Robin
SF - 1 vs 4; 2 vs 3 (Round 11)
F - Both SF winners (Round 12)
5 Rounds – Patron Trophy Round Robin (competition points do not carry over)
Patron Trophy Final – 1 vs 2 (Round 18)

<b>Men's Division One (Fourteen Teams, 16 rounds)</b>
13 Rounds – Round Robin
QF - 1 vs 8, 2 vs 7, 3 vs 6, 4 vs 5. 9 <sup>th</sup> , 11 <sup>th</sup> , and 13 <sup>th</sup> place also played
SF - Each QF winner plays (bracket is reseeded)
F - Both SF winners

<b>Women's Division One (Four Teams, 16 rounds)</b>
9 Rounds – Triple Round Robin
3 Rounds – Crossover Games vs French Cup teams (No Competition Points awarded). Crossover games played in Round 4, 8 and 10 (21 May, 25 June, 16 July)
QF - 1 vs 4; 2 vs 3
SF1 - Winners of QF Games play (winner direct to Grand Final); SF2 - Losers of QF games play (loser eliminated)
PF - Loser of SF1 plays winner of SF2
F - Winners of SF1 plays winner of PF

2 Rounds – Crossover Games vs French Cup teams (No Competition Points awarded). Crossover games played in Round 4, 8 and 10 (21 May, 25 June, 16 July, with one regular FC game played on these dates too)
QF1 2 vs 3; EF 4 vs 5. (1 direct to SF1, 6 Bye)
SF1 Winner of QF1 vs 1 (winner direct to Grand Final); SF2 Loser of QF1 vs winner WF. 6 <sup>th</sup> vs loser of EF (5 <sup>th</sup> place)
PF Loser of SF1 plays winner of SF2
F Winner of SF1 plays winner of PF

<b>Men's U23 A (Ten then Eleven Teams, 16 rounds)</b>
9 Rounds – Single Round Robin
5 Rounds – Top Six (competition points do not carry over to these rounds)
Or Plate Section
5 Rounds – Bottom Four, plus UC Development team (competition points do not carry over to these rounds)
SF 1 vs 4; 2 vs 3
Or Plate Grand Final, 1 vs 2 from Plate Section Round Robin (in round 15)
F Both SF winners

<b>Men's U23 Development (Five then Four Teams, 16 rounds)</b>
9 Rounds Double Round Robin with UC Development
6 Rounds, two more Round Robins (The Pioneer Yellow vs Checkers Synergiers result from July 1 will be counted twice to make the table results complete). All Results from games vs UC Development will be made equivalent for all teams.
F 1 vs 2 (in Round 15)

**Men's U20 A (Thirteen Teams, 16 rounds)**

12 Rounds – Round Robin (Pioneer-Cashmere added after Round Five).

Pioneer-Cashmere will start on five competitions points. Atami Spartans; UC-Christ's; Atami Kahu; NC Black; Checkers Red; SBC Checkers will all receive one competition point (in lieu of playing Pioneer-Cashmere). All other teams will play the other 12 teams over the course of the RR.

*Note – the competition committee will review results to determine if Pioneer-Cashmere, or one of the six teams who will not play Pioneer-Cashmere) should be seeded above their record at the end of Round 12 (i.e. the top seven teams are guaranteed to qualify for the Quarter Finals, and the competition committee will decide the eighth qualifier, and what seed this team will receive).*

QF 1 vs 4; 2 vs 3 and Elimination Finals 5 vs 8; 6 vs 7. 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> place also played (13 has a bye)

SF Losers of QF games play winners of elimination finals. Losers of EF play for 7<sup>th</sup> place. Winners of QF have a bye. 10<sup>th</sup> place also played (loser 9<sup>th</sup> place game vs winner 11<sup>th</sup>), 12<sup>th</sup> place also played (loser of 11<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>). 9<sup>th</sup> Place has a bye

PF Winners of QF games play SF winners.

F Winners of preliminary finals play

**Men's U20 Middle (Nine Teams, 16 rounds)**

14 Rounds – Double Round Robin

Each Match result will be duplicated, except for the following matchups, which will be played twice:

- Burnside Checkers vs Pioneer Yellow
- Burnside Checkers vs Rolleston Hawks
- Burnside Checkers vs Selwyn Blue
- Gators Red vs Pioneer Yellow
- Gators Red vs Rolleston Hawks
- Gators Red vs Selwyn Red
- Pioneer Yellow vs Rolleston Hawks
- Pioneer Yellow vs Selwyn Red
- Rolleston Hawks vs Selwyn Blue

All game results against Pioneer Cashmere will be removed, so at the end of 14 rounds, every team will have 18 game results credited (some single, and some double credit)

**Men's U20 Development (Three Teams, 16 rounds)**

14 Rounds – Quadruple Round Robin

All game results against Lions, UC-CBHS, and Checkers White will be removed, so at the end of 14 rounds, every team will have eight game results

The bye team each week will play a crossover (friendly) game against the bye team from the middle grade

SF 2 vs 3 (bye for 1)

F 1 vs SF winner

**Boys' U17 A (Twelve teams, 15 rounds)**

11 Rounds – Round Robin. Cashmere Maroon replaced Pioneer Blue in Round 7, and will start on six competition points.

Top 8 progress to playoffs

Or 3 Rounds – Bottom Four Round Robin (competition points do not carry over to these rounds)

*Note – the competition committee will review results to determine if Cashmere Maroon should be seeded above their record at the end of Round 11 (i.e. the top seven teams are guaranteed to qualify for the Quarter Finals, and the competition committee will decide the eighth qualifier, and what seed this team will receive).*

QF 1 vs 4; 2 vs 3 and Elimination Finals 5 vs 8; 6 vs 7.

SF Losers of QF games play winners of elimination finals. Losers of EF play for 7<sup>th</sup> place. Winners of QF have a bye

PF Winners of QF games play SF winners. Ladder games played (likely 5 vs 7 and 6 vs 8)

F Winners of preliminary finals play

**Girls' U16 (Nine Teams; 14 rounds)**

9 Rounds – RR

3 Rounds – Top Six split into two pools which play a Round Robin each. (Two even pools: A = 1,3,6; B = 2,4,5). No competition points carry over.

Or 3 Rounds – Bottom Three Round Robin (competition points do not carry over to these rounds), plus a friendly game vs team seeded 4, 5 or 6 for team with a bye in this pool.

<i>Note – the competition committee will review results to determine if the Riccarton Gators should be seeded above their record at the end of Round 11 (i.e. the top seven teams are guaranteed to qualify for the Quarter Finals, and the competition committee will decide the eighth qualifier, and what seed this team will receive).</i>
QF 1 vs 8, 2 vs 7, 3 vs 6, 4 vs 5. 9 <sup>th</sup> , and 11 <sup>th</sup> place Semi Finals played
SF Each QF winner plays (bracket is reseeded). 5 <sup>th</sup> , 7 <sup>th</sup> , 9 <sup>th</sup> and 11 <sup>th</sup> place games played
F Both SF winners

<b>Boys' U13 (Nine Teams; 12 rounds)</b>
9 Rounds - Round Robin. STC withdrew in round six, NC Lions to move sections after Round Robin
QF 1 bye (direct to SF); 2 vs 7; 3 vs 6; 4 vs 5
SF1 1 vs lowest seeded winner; SF2 other two winners play. 5 <sup>th</sup> place played between highest seeded QF losers. 7 <sup>th</sup> placed team to play a friendly vs a mid-section team
F Two SF winners

<b>Girls' U13 (Eight Teams; 12 rounds)</b>
7 Rounds - Round Robin
3 Rounds – Top Four or Bottom Four Round Robin
SF 1 vs 4, 2 vs 3. 5 <sup>th</sup> and 7 <sup>th</sup> place games played
F Both SF winners

<b>Midweek Men (Seven Teams, 16 rounds)</b>
14 Rounds - Double Round Robin
SF 1 vs 4, 2 vs 3, 5 <sup>th</sup> place also played (bye for 7 <sup>th</sup> )
F both SF winners

<b>Midweek Women (Eight Teams, 16 rounds)</b>
14 Rounds - Double Round Robin
